Treasurers Report:

- 1. Current balance: \$4,145;
- 2. AR consists of one balance due item: ~\$200 from Kidsports;

Non-HS Related Items:

- 1. BPCup is coming up, Aug 11-13, 2017:
 - \$300 mentorship subsidy for BPC, paid for by COSOA authorized by Steve;
 - Pat E. has spoken with Janet Irigoyen, the tournament assignor, and reports the following stats for upcoming BPCup: 414 games, half of them are solo CTR (u12 and below), 92 refs, 44 local; typ assign grade 6s and 7s first as well as out of town refs first;
 - Local refs should fill out availability on OSC website;
 - BPCup field sites: Sisters, Cascade Acad, Ponderosa, Buckingham, Big Sky, Summit HS, among others;
 - Housing (Mike A. volunteered again this year) looking for housing for 43 refs (14 rooms so far thru timbers families);
 - Reminder that refs working the BPCup receive lunch each day, as well as taco feed dinner on Sat night.

2. CASA:

- higher pay negotiated, from \$50 to \$55 per game for CASA, effective beginning of season;
- COSOA has billed CASA through first half of season;
- CASA is one long season and one 8 -team playoffs at end thru Oct;

3. HS Commissioner's Report:

- Mehdi S. went to State mtg in Wilsonville;
- Rule changes PPT: main things: KO can go an direction and stutter on PK allowed PPT given to Steve K. to present at 1st general membership meeting;
- Schools have provided schedules, still need JV scheds (will be ~300 games);
- Schools have received pre-season billings from COSOA;
- Under-18 youth now allowed to ref HS, with certain criteria needing to be met;
- OSAA shows only 7 refs signed up so far (last year we had 33) priority is to get everyone registered;
- HS Jamboree date: 8/24;
- Oregon rules differences reminders for test questions discussed;
- Quick OCEP reminder, once every 3 yrs;
- OCEP Playoff eligibility now involves requnit to attend a qualified training every 5 yrs, starting 2016;
- Officials are not to comment on OSAA rules and procedures on ejections or fines direct all such questions to school AD's;
- #1 injury prone sport in OSAA is women's soccer, men's soccer is 3rd;
- No OT allowed anywhere in state any longer for regular season (applies mainly to Sisters);

- Mehdi S. to forward OSAA pay schedule to Mike P. for posting to COSOA website;
- Mileage pay rate is the same as last year maintain \$.20 per mile per person, \$5 minimum, regardless of who drives, carpools, etc.;
- Town of Paisley has let COSOA know that their HS has soccer program this year with 2 home games (135mile one way from Bend) one against La Pine JV, and one against Central Christian; these games are currently scheduled for a Monday night and a Saturday;
- Regarding mileage to/from Paisley same rate as all games for the mileage, and mention to refs at 1st COSOA mtg;
- No Culver this year program blended with Redmond;
- Redmond-Ridgeview has one shared AD between the two schools this year;
